QUICK START GUIDE RET-MASTER

1. Charge the Battery. Connect the RET-Master Power Supply to an AC Outlet. Normally the battery will fully charge in less than three hours.

Note: To charge the battery after a long period of non-use, plug in the charger until the charge led turns green, then unplug the charger and plug it back in again. The battery may take 5 to 6 full discharge/charge cycles to regain full capacity after an extended period of non-use.

- 2. **Download the App.** Download the free app "RET-Master" from the Apple Store, for an Apple device or from the Google Play Store for an android device.
- 3. Turn on the power to the RET-Master.



Connect your MOBILE device to the RET-Master Wi-Fi. In your settings Menu, select the Wi-Fi SSID that begins with "RM", as shown below.

5. Open the RET-Master Application.

The user will be prompted to install any new versions of the app if they exist.

- Select the "Help" tab to view the RET-Master Operations Manual. (On smaller displays, "Help" will be under the "More" tab.)
- 7. Connect AISG devices to the female AISG port, as shown below.



8. Select **Find Devices** when ready.

Wear shoes with rubber soles and heels. Wear protective clothing including a long-sleeved shirt and rubber gloves.
