

Installation Sheet for Universal Port

1. Product Introduction

This instruction is to demonstrate the faceplate or Surface-Mounting-Box (SMB) with universal port. The universal port can be mounted with M-series modular Jack and SL / SLX series modular Jack, KJ modular jack can be mounted with a SL adapter.


2. These instructions apply to all Universal opening series Faceplates, SMBs and Adapters.

3. Modular Jack Installation steps

- 3.1 Terminate the modular jack according to the modular jack installation instructions. And install terminated modular Jack into faceplate proceed as follows.
- 3.2 SL / SLX series modular jack install


Step 1: Insert the modular jack by aligning the slotted side first, seating <u>Non-deflecting Latch [1]</u> on bottom side.

Step 2: Pivot the modular jack or insert forward until the <u>Deflecting Latch [2]</u> engages the off-set rail of the port and snaps into place. Refer to Figure 3.




3.3 KJ series modular Jack install.

Step1: Install the adapter according to the assembly direction of Figure 4. For products with adapters sold separately, adapter can be ordered under MID (760248426).


Step 2: Insert the modular jack by aligning the slotted side first, seating <u>Non-deflecting Latch</u> [1] on bottom side.

Step 3: Pivot the modular jack or insert forward until the <u>Deflecting Latch [2]</u> engages the off-set rail of the port and snaps into place. Refer to Figure 5.



- 3.4 M series modular jack install,
 - Install the modular jack according to the assembly direction of Figure 6.



4 Remove modular jack from the Universal Ports.


4.1. Remove SL and KJ series modular jack, refer to figure 7.

Step1: Insert the tip of a small flat screwdriver over the deflecting latch of the modular jack.

Step2: Rotate it slightly to release the deflecting latch.

Step3: Pull the modular jack out of the back of the port.

- 4.2 Remove M series modular Jack.
- 4.2.1 Remove from un-shuttered port, refer to figure 8.

Step1: Insert the Outlet Removal Tool (760122713) or screwdriver over the latch of the modular jack.

Step2: Pull the modular jack out of the back of the port.



4.2.2 Remove from single layer shuttered port. refer to figure 9.

Step1: insert screwdriver over the latch of the modular jack from the rear side.

Step2: pivot and pull the modular jack out of the back of the port.






4.2.3 Remove from Double layer shuttered port. refer to figure 10.

Step 1: Insert screwdriver to remove the cover.

Step 2: Insert the Outlet Removal Tool (760122713) over the latch of the modular jack.

Step 3: Pull the modular jack out of the back of the port.



Note:


- 1. Shuttered modular jack can't work with shutter series faceplate.
- 2. High Density M-Series Adapter (figure 10) can't work with shuttered series faceplate.



3. Modular jack installation direction is back to back on the 4 port shutter faceplater, refer to figure 11.
